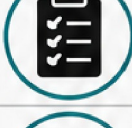
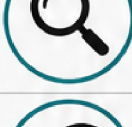




POST-ACCIDENT CHECKLIST

SMART STEPS TODAY. SAFER REPAIRS TOMORROW.

Use this checklist to protect your safety, your rights, and your vehicle after an accident.

	1	CHECK FOR INJURIES & CALL 911 IF NEEDED • Ensure everyone is safe. • Call 911 for injuries or if the accident is blocking traffic.	☐
	2	DOCUMENT THE SCENE • Take photos of all vehicles, damage, license plates, road conditions, and anything relevant. • Get contact information from all drivers, passengers, and witnesses.	☐
	3	FILE A POLICE REPORT (IF APPLICABLE) • Required for injuries, major damage, or disputes. • The report can be important for your insurance claim.	☐
	4	NOTIFY YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY • Report the accident as soon as possible. • Provide facts only – avoid speculating or admitting fault.	☐
	5	DECIDE ON TOWING & STORAGE • Use a towing company of your choice. • Ask about storage fees and daily rates.	☐
	6	DO NOT AUTHORIZE REPAIRS YET • Have your vehicle inspected by a trusted repair facility first. • Get a written repair estimate before approving anything.	☐
	7	REVIEW THE INSURANCE ESTIMATE CAREFULLY • Check for missing repairs, parts, ADAS scans/calibrations, and OEM parts. • Don't be afraid to ask questions or request supplements.	☐
	8	STAY IN COMMUNICATION • Keep all records, photos, receipts, and correspondence. • Follow up with your insurance company and repair shop regularly.	☐

- ✓ You have the right to understand your estimate.
